

Truth: children will learn:

- God knows who I am.
- God knows all about me.

Scripture: Psalm 139:13-14 (You will need: A hairbrush or comb of your own for the lesson) and Luke 12:7

To start: Have crayons or colored markers and blank sheets of paper before you start the lesson. Ask your kids to think of someone who is very special to them, and then draw a picture showing why they are so special. When finished, ask them to talk about their drawings. (If you want—you can attach an I am special to your child and let them know they are so special to you and so very special to Jesus)

Lesson:

(say/ask) Did you know that God knew you before you were born, and He knows you now! God knows all about me.

Show a hairbrush.

(say) I don't know how many hairs I have on my own head. I suppose that I could try and count them. But even if I managed to count them, every day I lose some hairs and every day some new hairs grow! You can see from my hairbrush that today I have already lost some.

(Pull out one hair from hairbrush.)

(say) But God knows the number of hairs on my head, and on yours too! (And He knows everything else about us too!)

• Luke 12:7 Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

Song: Sing the song *Jesus Loves Me*

Jesus loves me, This I know. For the Bible tells me so, Little ones to Him belong. They are weak, But He is strong.

Yes Jesus loves me, Yes Jesus loves me, Yes Jesus loves me. The Bible tells me so.

Prayer:

Let's pray and thank God for His love.

Thank you that you love me.

Thank you for knowing me.

Thank you for never changing.
